

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will ensure the longevity and functionality of your chair. This guide provides instructions for cleaning, troubleshooting, and general maintenance.

General Guidelines

Usage Conditions:

Use the chair only for its intended purpose.

Avoid standing on the chair or subjecting it to heavy impact.

Do not exceed the specified weight capacity.

Regular Inspection:

Periodically check for loose screws, bolts, or parts.

Tighten components as needed to prevent wear and tear.

Cleaning & Care

Fabric Upholstery

Regular Cleaning:

Vacuum with a soft brush attachment to remove dust and debris.

Spot Cleaning:

Use a mild detergent diluted in water.

Apply with a soft cloth, blotting gently. Avoid soaking.

Deep Cleaning:

Use a professional upholstery cleaner or seek professional services.

Leather or Faux Leather

Dust Removal:

Wipe with a dry, soft cloth weekly.

Cleaning:

Use a damp cloth with a mild soap solution.

Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.





Conditioning:

Apply leather conditioner once every six months to maintain suppleness.

Mesh

Vacuuming:

Use a vacuum cleaner with a gentle setting to remove dust.

Spot Cleaning:

Use a mild detergent and soft cloth. Rinse with a damp cloth.

Plastic and Metal Components

Dust and Dirt Removal:

Wipe with a damp cloth. For tough spots, use a mild cleaning agent.

Polishing:

Use a polish designed for plastic or metal to maintain shine.

<u>Adjustments and Maintenance</u>

Gas Lift Cylinder

Ensure smooth height adjustment by using the lever gently.

If the gas lift loses its effectiveness, it may require replacement.

Casters (Wheels)

Cleaning:

Remove debris or hair from the casters monthly.

Use a damp cloth to clean.

Lubrication:

Apply a silicone-based lubricant if wheels are not rolling smoothly.

Tilt Mechanism

Adjust tilt settings as per instructions.

Lubricate moving parts every 6–12 months with a light machine oil.

Armrests

Inspect screws or bolts for tightness.
Wipe with a soft damp cloth to clean.

Common Issues and Fixes		
<u>Issue</u>	Cause	Solution
Chair won't adjust height	Faulty gas lift	Replace gas lift cylinder
<u>Squeaky noises</u>	Lack of lubrication	Apply lubricant to moving parts
Uneven or wobbly chair	Loose screws or uneven floor	Tighten screws or use a floor mat
Wheels not rolling smoothly	Debris in casters	Clean and lubricate casters
Tilt mechanism not working	Jammed mechanism or tension adjustment	Check settings or lubricate mechanism
